

Québec Studies is accepting applications for the position of Associate Editor for Book Reviews.

The ACQS Board invites nominations from U.S.-based or international scholars. Candidates should have the ability to work in both official languages; strong organizational skills and some editorial experience will be preferred. This volunteer position may count as service to the profession for purposes of tenure and/or promotion. The position will begin in early summer 2021, with a training period through winter; full duties to be assumed in January 2022. The journals' Associate Editors may be invited to serve as ex officio members of the ACQS Board.

The book reviews editor will:

- correspond with publishers and determine which books will be reviewed
- identify appropriate reviewers before asking publishers to mail the books directly to the reviewers
- give detailed instructions (format, length, style, etc.) to reviewers
- receive, edit, and format the reviews before sending files to the Editor-in-chief.
- review page proofs of the reviews section prior to publication.
